✓ PROJECT PROMPT

Create a 30–60 second cinematic micro-story.

- Film **3–5 intentional shots** using cinematic framing and movement
- Add **ambient sound & music** for emotion
- Apply **basic color grading** to give it a film-like mood

By the end, you'll have a **mini cinematic sequence** that feels like a short film, even if you shot it on your phone.

✓ BONUS TIPS

- **Plan your shots before filming.** Even 3 simple story beats (beginning, middle, end) make it feel intentional.
- **Keep it minimal.** One strong subject + good lighting > cluttered visuals.
- **Sound carries emotion.** Good audio design can elevate even basic footage.
